Priority and thrust of our college has always been imparting good education to the students. Never thought of pandemic struck in March 2020 and followed by a lock down declared by the government. It created an uncertainty in every field. Education was no exception. Delivering online lectures to the students was a challenge but our college was quick and positive in responding to the challenges posed by the pandemic. Some of the actions taken that portray our performance include -

1. Quick shift to the online mode of teaching-learning and evaluation at first year to masters' level for Commerce and at the undergraduate level for B.B.A. and BBA (CA) programmes. It was decided to promote the first and the second year students to the next classes on a provisional basis. This was done so as to start their next academic year well in time. This made sure that there was no learning gap. We started teaching online from June 16, 2020 and were the first among the colleges under the University to do so. Never did we let the quality of education to fall. Teachers were given the academic flexibility.
2. Admissions were completely online without having to endanger the lives of the students. Documents in support of their claims for admission were sought only when the effect of pandemic subsided and the Covid-19 norms were relaxed by the government. Financial needs of the students were taken care of by taking a number measures in the form of – teachers and alumni financing students, shifting of financially needy students to aided section from the unaided, giving easy installment to pay the fees etc.
